We will be focusing on 1:1 counting and knowing the last number is the total. We will further develop our understanding of numbers to 5. We will begin to explore language of measure.

Understanding the World

We will be observing and discussing the changes we see outside. We will be learning about festivals around the world including Halloween, Diwali, bonfire night and Christmas. We will be exploring toys from the past and how they are the same/different to the toys we have now.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development
