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Reading Update– For Children in Year R, Year 1 and Year 2.

We are very excited to announce our new online reading books, Big Cat Collins. These books support our phonic scheme, Little Wandle, and are used in class.

We will be switching over to eBooks, to make it easier for your child to access their current class reading book, as well as previous books they have had. We hope this helps with engaging the children as well. If you are not able to access the eBooks, we will, of course, provide a hard copy for you.

By using eBooks, we are hoping to minimise the amount of books that get damaged or lost.

Your child will be assigned reading books that they are reading as part of the phonics scheme in class, and these will have been matched to their phonic level. Teachers will assign your child a new book every week.
