RWI Parents information Meeting


Thank you so much to all of you who attended our Read, Write Inc phonics meeting this week. It was lovely to share how we teach phonics with you all. If you were unable to make the meeting you will be sent home a parent's booklet



that will answer any questions that you might have. Your children have been bringing home Storybooks to share with you and should be able to read every word within their book. The children read each Storybook three times at school and again with you at home. On each reading, children's fluency increases and the more they can focus on what the story is about. Re-reading the same book helps children to become confident readers. They have also been bringing home a Book Bag Book which links to the story they have read in class which again only contains sounds that your child is confident reading.
















Parents Evenings
