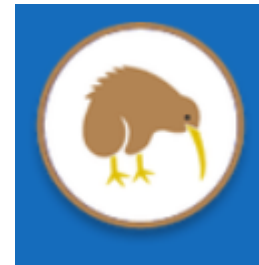

## Kiwi Best Behaviour Curriculum (BBC)

We are pleased to announce the launch of our best behaviour curriculum or BBC for short. As a school we are focusing on a teaching a different aspect every month there will be a set of guidelines for pupil to follow and also a set of guidelines for staff.

For the month of January our theme is ***Lining Up and Moving Around***. Staff and pupils have taken part in an assembly on Tuesday to discuss expectations for Lining Up and Moving Around the school safely. We talked to the children about our BEST values and how we can show these values in the way we behave while moving around school. This is to help children think about their BEST behaviour and also about how we show respect and kindness to each other by doing things such as holding doors open and using manners. Children are currently earning points for demonstrating how they should line up and move around safely. Our school council will make a decision as to what the reward will be for the children with the most points. Please have a conversation about how they earn points.

### Smart Squirrel

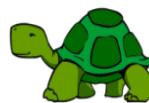
We make good choices about our learning and behaviour.
