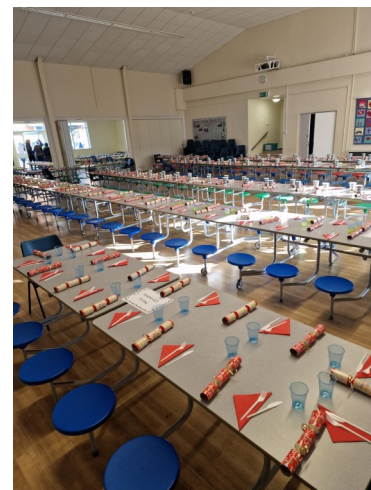
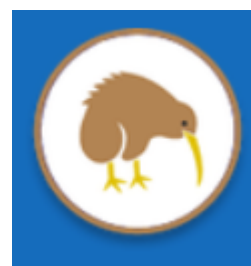

Christingle

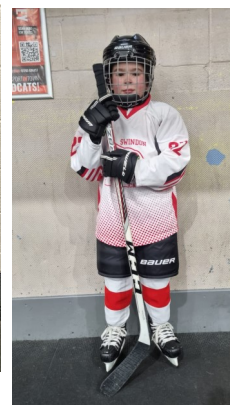
