Mental Health Awareness

As a Thrive school we really work hard to ensure our children are aware of their Mental Health. Mrs Leach is our Mental Health Senior lead. We have our own team of Wellbeing Ambassadors across school. These are children who have taken on the role to promote and support the mental health and well-being of all our children in school. Meeting monthly, the children gather feedback from across the school, develop ideas to promote and educate pupils on well-being and mental health and then feedback to classes. They are on hand at playtime an lunchtime to support daily and can be identified by their Wellbeing Ambassador badges. Within Kiwi School, all our staff follow a Thrive approach in class and across the wider school. We offer Thrive sessions and ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistants) with our trained Thrive and ELSA team. Please look at our pages on our school website for information on these.
