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
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Take One Book



Street Child by Berlie Doherty

LITERACY

This term, we will be reading *Street Child* by Berlie Doherty. This is a classic story about a boy living on the streets during the Victorian Era. We will use the context of the story to learn about diary writing and we will imagine we are street children and write our own diary entries. We will also immerse ourselves in Victorian London and learn how to use language effectively and creatively to write powerful setting descriptions. We will begin to use more mature, technical features in our writing this term such as fronted adverbials and relative clauses.

PSHE

In PSHE, our next unit is called 'Valuing difference'. This next unit teachers us to respect and accept differences and embrace our diversity. We will learn about friendship and how good friends should behave and we will learn about the importance of sharing.

HISTORY

Our topic this term is called How have children's lives changed over time? We will be learning to use a range of sources to understand what childhood was like at different point in history.

COMPUTING

The children will be learning to use some basic coding software and learning to programme some simple code. We will be using SCRATCH and will also learn how to debug programmes.

MATHEMATICS

In maths this term, we will continue to focus on securing core skills in addition and subtraction. We will make sure we are confident exchanging and using 4-digit numbers when adding and subtracting. We will begin learning how to multiply efficiently using 2 and 3-digit numbers and we will be learning our 6 and 8 times tables. We will constantly be revisiting skills and knowledge from term 1.

Autumn Term 2 2022 Year 4

THEME: 'Take One Book'

SCIENCE

This term, the children will be covering the topic 'Digestion and the digestive system.' This unit will cover all animals, their digestive systems including teeth and health and nutrition.

HOMEWORK

Practice the weekly spellings and complete times table rockstars.

<u>P.E.</u>

In dance this term, the children will be learning to expressive narratives with movements. They will tell the story of a child living in a Victorian workhouse. We will also do Hockey this term and learn how to identify and move into space.
